### FY2010 RATE SCHEDULE EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2009

TO ALL SCMUA CUSTOMERS:

Attached is a copy of the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority's FY2010 Rate Schedule. A Rate Hearing was held on Tuesday, November 24, 2009 at 4:30 p.m. at the SCMUA Administrative Building, Commissioners Meeting Room, 34 South Route 94, Lafayette, New Jersey. The FY2010 Rate Schedule was adopted by the Board of Commissioners at the November 24, 2009 meeting.

Highlights of the revised Rate Schedule include:

- A. Septage and sludge treatment rates will remain at 2009 rates currently charged.
- B. The hauled sewage rate is to be set at \$9.41 per 1,000 gallons.
- C. Sewage treatment service charges for the Upper Walkkill & Hampton Commons Facilities (see schedule).
- D. Connection fees for the Upper Walkkill System are to be set at \$4,988 per EDU for FY2010
- E. Review fees (see schedule).
- F. Solid waste disposal charges are to be amended in FY2010. The posted or maximum tip fee shall be \$122.00 per ton. The charge for bulk tire disposal shall be 3 times the \$122.00 rate or \$366.00 per ton. Disposal of "Extra Bulky" waste shall be 2½ times the \$122.00 rate or \$305.00 per ton. Asbestos disposal shall be 2 times the \$122.00 per ton rate or \$244.00 per ton. **See the attached Resolution revising the Solid Waste Facilities FY2010 Schedule of Rates – Amendment #1 for specific tipping fees effective December 1, 2009.** Further adjustments in the tipping fees will be impacted by availability of State/County Aid and/or approval of pending Sussex County Solid Waste Management Plan Amendment to re-establish solid waste flow control.
- G. All refrigerators, air conditioners and dehumidifiers requiring removal of CFC's (Freon Gas) shall be surcharged \$10.00 per unit.
- H. Residents Type 10 per bag waste disposal charges shall remain at \$0.13 per pound, with a minimum \$0.50 charge.
