RESOLUTION:

AUTHORIZING CONTINUED MEMBERSHIP AND RENEWAL OF A COOPERATIVE PRICING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SCMUA AND THE SOMERSET COUNTY COOPERATIVE PRICING SYSTEM FOR THE PERIOD OF FEBRUARY 1, 2025 THROUGH PERPETUITY

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(5) authorizes contracting units to establish a Cooperative Pricing System and to enter into Cooperative Pricing Agreements for its administration; and

WHEREAS, the Somerset County, hereinafter referred to as the "Lead Agency" has offered voluntary participation in the Somerset County Cooperative Pricing System #2 - SOCCP a Cooperative Pricing System for the purchase of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, retroactive to February 1, 2025 the governing body of the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey wishes to continue participation in the Somerset County Cooperative Pricing System for the provision and performance of goods and services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as follows:

- 1. This Resolution shall be known and may be cited as the Cooperative Pricing Resolution of the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority.
- 2. Pursuant to the provision of N.J.S.A. 40A:11 -11(5), the SCMUA Comptroller Timothy Day is hereby authorized to enter into a Cooperative Pricing Agreement with the Lead Agency.
- 3. The County of Somerset shall on behalf of all local units participating in the cooperative pricing system renew the system every 5 years in perpetuity; unless all parties give written notice that there is no longer a desire or a need for participation in the system. Renewal of the system will be in accordance with the provisions of N.J.A.C. 5:34-7.6, as may be amended.
- 4. The Lead Agency shall be responsible for complying with the provisions of the Local Public Contract Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) and all other provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey.
- 5. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:14B 14(e).
