RESOLUTION RE: AUTHORIZING THE AWARD TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE AND

RESPONSIVE BIDDER FOR CONTRACT NO. 21-08 FOR THE FURNISH AND DELIVERY OF ONE NEW WALKING FLOOR TRANSFER TRAILER

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter "Authority") has advertised for bids for Contract No. 21-08 on August 12, 2021 in the New Jersey Herald for the furnishing and delivery of one (1) New Walking Floor Transfer Trailer for the Authority's Solid Waste Facility in Lafayette, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, one sealed bid was received and opened by the Authority on August 24, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. after notice and solicitation in accordance with the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A.40A:11-1, et.seq.); and

WHEREAS, Horwith Trucks, Inc. of Northhampton, PA. was the lone bidder with a bid for One Walking Floor Transfer Trailer at \$93,609.00, less a Trade-In Allowance of \$20,000.00, for a Total Bid Price of \$73,609.00; and

WHEREAS, the Authority hereby rejects the Trade-In Allowance to obtain a higher value at auction, which has been deemed the most beneficial for the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's staff and Attorney have reviewed the Bid Proposal and contract language, and recommends award thereof to Horwith Trucks, Inc. as based upon the accepted Bid Price for One Walking Floor Transfer Trailer for a Total Bid Price of \$93,609.00; and

WHEREAS, the Treasurer has certified that there are sufficient funds in the Solid Waste Renewal & Replacement Fund for equipment procurement and contract award.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

- 1. Contract No. 21-08 for the furnishing and delivery of One New Walking Floor Transfer Trailer is hereby awarded to Horwith Trucks, Inc. for a Total Bid Price of \$93,609.00; and
- 2. The proper officers of this Authority, and its employees are hereby authorized to proceed with the preparation and execution of a formal contract and Purchase Order with Horwith Trucks, Inc. as set forth above, pursuant to the terms and conditions of this resolution and pursuant to terms and conditions of the Bid previously submitted by Horwith Trucks, Inc. and the specifications in connection therewith.
- 3. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with applicable NJ laws and statutes.
