

Used Cooking Oil Recycling



Cooking oils can cause problems for kitchen plumbing, septic systems and sewage collection systems. Recycled cooking oils can be recycled into a fuel that can be used by diesel engines! Reduce food waste going to the landfill!

Sussex County residents can recycle used cooking oils **FOR FREE** at SCMUA's Recycling Center.

How to recycle used cooking oil:



- Allow the used cooking oil to cool.
- Carefully pour the used cooking oil into a sturdy plastic or wax-coated leak proof container, such as the original container or a juice carton, no larger than 5-gallons in size.
- Cap the container so it is secure.
- Store the container in a cool, safe location until full.
- **Don't mix** the used cooking oil with other liquids or products.
- Bring full containers to the SCMUA's Recycling Center during normal business hours to pour into a collection tank.
