

Electronics Recycling (E-Waste)

FREE Drop-off any day*: TV's, computers, printers and fax machines!

New Jersey's *Electronic Waste Management Act* prohibits consumers from disposing of the following "Covered Electronic Devices (CEDs)":

- *Desktop or Personal computers*
- *Computer monitors*
- *Portable computers (laptops, tablets)*
- *Desktop printers*
- *Desktop fax machines*
- *Televisions*



Recycling electronics keeps toxic materials and heavy metals out of the landfill and allows recovery of valuable materials including metals, plastic and glass!

The **SCMUA** serves as a collection site for Covered Electronic Devices for residents, schools, government entities and small businesses.

SCMUA Collection Events:

At the Spring and Fall Collection Events, CEDs and Non-CEDs are accepted for recycling at no charge including computers, TV's, printers, fax machines, keyboards, mice, speakers, audio equipment, wires and scanners. **Not accepted** during the events: Motor vehicle electronic devices and appliances (microwave, air conditioner, dehumidifier, air purifier).

***SCMUA Drop-off Program:**

Desktop computers/printers/fax machines and TVs are accepted at the *Residents Convenience Area* Monday-Saturday from 7:00 am-2:00 pm at no charge. Other electronics may also be dropped off for a fee of \$0.13/lb.

Retail and Manufacturer Recycling:

Staples, Best Buy and other retail stores and manufacturers offer a variety of options to donate or recycle electronics. See the links below for more information.
