## RESOLUTION RE: CONDITIONALLY AWARDING LEACHATE PUMP STATION AND FORCE MAIN PROJECT FOR CONTRACT #446 TO TOMCO CONSTRUCTION, INC.

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority (SCMUA) desires to construct the Leachate Pump Station and Force Main to convey leachate from the SCMUA Solid Waste Facility to the SCMUA Franklin Regional Pump Station and ultimately to the SCMUA Upper Wallkill Pollution Control Facility to serve the solid waste management and disposal needs for the residents and businesses of Sussex County; and

WHEREAS, the SCMUA subsequently did plan, permit and design the Project pursuant to the Sussex County Solid Waste Management Plan, and the requirements of various Federal, State and Local agencies and authorities; and

WHEREAS, this Project is anticipated to be funded by the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) funding program through NJDEP; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the NJIB Authorization, the SCMUA duly advertised for, and on July 14, 2020 received competitive construction bids for the Project in conformance with N.J. Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11 et seq); and

WHEREAS, a total of five (5) bidders submitted bids for Contract #446 comprising the Leachate Pump Station and Force Main Project; and

WHEREAS, the apparent low bidder for Contract #446 is determined to be Tomco Construction, Inc. with a Total Bid including Supplemental Item No. 1 and Supplemental Item No. 2 in the amount of \$5,498,098.00; and

WHEREAS, SCMUA staff, consulting engineer, legal counsel, and NJDEP/NJIB are in the process of reviewing said bid package for the purposes of evaluating award thereof to Tomco Construction, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, due to the urgency and need for this project to ensure the continued and proper management of solid waste for Sussex County residents and businesses, it is recommended that the contract be conditionally awarded subject to ongoing said reviews, evaluations, and approvals; and

WHEREAS, NJDEP/NJIB Authorization to Award is required to preserve funding eligibility for this project; and

WHEREAS, the Treasurer has certified that there are existing sufficient funds for this contract award.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Commissioners of the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority, that:

- 1. Contract #446 of the SCMUA Leachate Pump Station and Force Main Project is hereby awarded to Tomco Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$5,498,098.00 as conditioned/contingent upon #3, below.
- 2. The SCMUA Chairman and Secretary are authorized to execute Contract #446 for the Leachate Pump Station and Force Main Project on behalf of the SCMUA, as contingent upon #3, below.
- 3. The award of SCMUA Contract #446 is contingent upon the review and concurrence of SCMUA staff, consulting engineer, legal counsel, and NJDEP/NJIB.
- 4. SCMUA Executive Director and staff are authorized to proceed with any necessary project and contract activities associated with Leachate Pump Station and Force Main Construction, including submittal of the Bid Award Package and supporting documents to NJDEP/NJIB.
- 5. Copies of this Award Resolution shall be provided to NJDEP/NJIB and Tomco Construction, Inc.
- 6. This resolution shall be effective as provided for under applicable NJ State Statutes.
