WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey, Division of Archives and Records Management (DARM) has approved and authorized said request for disposal (Authorization# 598323); and



WHEREAS, the local public contracts law requires that the Resolution authorizing the award of a contract for Professional Services and the Agreement itself, must be available for public inspection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

1. That the Chairman and Secretary of the Authority are hereby authorized and directed to execute a Professional Services Agreement between SCMUA and Mott MacDonald for provision of general and specialized wastewater consulting engineering services, a true copy of which contract is annexed hereto as Attachment A, is hereby effective February 7, 2024 through February 28, 2025.
2. That said contract be and is hereby awarded utilizing the "Fair and Open" process pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44 – 20.4, et seq.



3. That one (1) copy of this Resolution, together with the contract itself, upon the execution thereof, shall be made available at the SCMUA's offices for public inspection during the normal business hours of said office.
4. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:14B-14(e).
