- WHEREAS, the SCMUA has a need for upgrades to the Audio-Visual Equipment within the Board of Commissioners meeting room; and
- WHEREAS, the scope of work includes a fully updated system which encompasses new monitors, camera, microphones, speakers, audio recorder and all other necessary auxiliary equipment for a fully operable system; and
- WHEREAS, SCMUA requested proposals from the following companies: CSAV Systems, AVA Audio Visual Associates, and BIS Digital; and
- WHEREAS, SCMUA received proposals from CSAV Systems and BIS Digital at prices of \$36,109.00 and \$37,625.00 respectively; and
  - WHEREAS, AVA Audio Visual Associates was non-responsive; and
- WHEREAS, both proposals received meet the requirements for Public Meetings in accordance with New Jersey State Statutes; and
- WHEREAS, the proposals have been reviewed with the Information Technology Committee and the committee found the proposed work to be necessary and the price to be reasonable; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to review by SCMUA Staff, it was determined that CSAV Systems proposal met all SCMUA requirements and was the most cost efficient and fiscally responsible; and
- WHEREAS, all labor and equipment required for a fully functioning system is included in the proposal; and
- WHEREAS, the Authority's Qualified Purchasing Agent has reviewed and recommended approval of this contract award; and
- WHEREAS, the Authority's Treasurer has certified sufficient funds are available for the contract award.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the proposed R&R Outlay expenditure transfers are required and are to be recorded under a separate SCMUA Resolution formally amending said Solid Waste Capital Budget.
