RESOLUTION RE: AUTHORIZATION FOR SPECIAL LEGAL COUNSEL TO PURSU#25-117 DEBT COLLECTION FROM VERNON TOWNSHIP AND THE VERNON TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY FOR SEWER SERVICE CHARGES, UP TO AND INCLUDING THE FILING OF LITIGATION

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority ("SCMUA") provides sewer services to various system participants within the Upper Wallkill System, including Vernon Township; and

WHEREAS, despite notice and monthly billing of same, Vernon Township has failed to remit payment of sewer service charges owed to SCMUA in accordance with the applicable sewer service contract; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has made reasonable efforts to resolve the matter amicably, including written request for payment of sewer service charges, but Vernon Township has failed or refused to remit payment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds it necessary and in the best interest of the other SCMUA Upper Wallkill System participants to pursue collection of outstanding debt from Vernon Township; and

WHEREAS, SCMUA has previously appointed Thomas Prol of Sills Cummis and Gross, P.C. as special legal counsel; and

WHEREAS, the SCMUA has determined that legal action is necessary to recover the sewer service charges and to protect the other Upper Wallkill System participants, as well as the financial integrity of the sewer utility system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority, that special legal counsel is hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary steps to pursue collection of outstanding sewer service charges due from Vernon Township, including but not limited to the filing of litigation, in order to secure payment of all sums owed to SCMUA; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the SCMUA Chairman, Executive Director, staff, and General Counsel are authorized to coordinate with special legal counsel and take any additional actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
